

Project sheet number 1 The egg-cellent egg-odile

What you will need:

- Two egg boxes - 1 for a dozen and one for half a dozen eggs
- Four toilet roll tubes
- White, black and dark green paint
- Bright red paper
- Glue
- Sticky tape
- Needle and thread or string
- Varnish is optional



Step 1

Make sure you paint the egg boxes and loo rolls green before you start to build your crocodile.

Step 2

Once the green paint has dried, paint white claws on the four rolls, which will be the legs. When the paint dries you can varnish the rolls for a harder finish if you want to.



Step 3

Now tie together the two parts of half dozen egg box to form the crocodile's jaws (ask an adult for help if you need too).



Step 4

Next, glue the head and body together and paint on the eyes and nostrils. Again once the paint is dry you can varnish your craft croc to give it a longer life.

Step 5

Draw and cut out the tongue from bright red paper and stick it inside your croc's mouth with sticky tape.

Step 6

Now glue the ready-painted legs in spaces on the underside of the body.

Now you have an egg-cellent new pet!
