Application to correct the register

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Mr Gordon Richard Jackson** to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, concerning the right on CL26 - Skinburness and Calvo Marshes described more fully below.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 3 stints (one stint being equal one beast or 4 sheep or 2 ewes and young lambs) on Skinburness and Calvo Marshes comprising the whole of the land in this register unit is currently registered as held in gross at Entry 206 of register unit CL26 in the name of Gordon Richard Jackson of Raby Grange, Kirkbride, Wigton, CA7 5HJ. Mr Jackson's address changed to Marshside, Skinburness, Wigton, CA7 4RA and by this application he seeks to record his new address in the Register .

If the application is granted, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by amending the Register to show Mr Gordon Richard Jackson's new address in column 3.
