NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Parish Council of Dacre** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19 (2) paragraph (a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL356 Watering Place opposite Tymparon Hall, Dacre.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: the Applicant claims that part of the "public watering place" described in a decision notice of the Commons Commissioner dated 27 July 1985, was not included on the official map of registered common land unit CL356 (the part claimed to be omitted is shown coloured red on the attached plan and marked as the "Application Land"). The Applicant claims that when making the amendment, the Commons Registration Authority made a mapping error by ending the boundary of the "watering place" on the margin of the map instead of extending onto the next map in the series. The Applicant requests that the boundary of common land on the official map be amended to include the Application land, which encompasses the whole of the physical structure of the watering place.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by preparing a new edition of the official map showing the Application Land as registered common land (see attached plan).

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA10/7**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on 21st April 2016.

Documents relating to the application are not available online; these are only available for inspection at The Commons Registration Service at the above address, strictly by appointment only. Please contact the Commons Registration Team on (01228) 221026 to arrange an appointment.
