

**The Commons Act 2006 - Schedule 2 Paragraph 7
NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT MISTAKEN REGISTRATION**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **David Rawling** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 2 paragraph 7 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL196 Sand Pit, Hayton Town Head.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: the application relates to the whole of the land registered in register unit CL196 (edged red on the attached map and hereinafter referred to as the "Application Land"). The Application Land was provisionally registered as common land on 4th September 1969 under section 4 of the Commons Registration Act 1965, pursuant to application number 756 made on 18th June 1968 by Hayton Parish Council. The provisional registration, being undisputed, became final on 1st August 1972. The Applicant claims that the Application Land was wrongly registered as common land by the Clerk of Hayton Parish Council and has requested the removal of the Application Land from the commons register.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the commons registration authority will give effect to the determination by deregistering the Application Land, which will entail the strikethrough of the current register entries of unit number CL196, the addition of a register amendment entry confirming deregistration of the whole and amendment or preparation of fresh edition of the register map showing the Application Land marked as deregistered.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA13/6**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on 10th June 2016
