Application to correct the register – mistake made by the registration authority.

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: CA10/7

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee (“the Committee”) on the 23rd June 2016, considered an application to correct a mistake in the register made by the CRA concerning the registration of land adjacent to common land register unit CL356 Watering Place opposite Tymparon Hall, Newbiggin, Dacre (herein after referred to as “the Application Land) as common land.

Decision

The Committee resolved to accept the application to correct the register and add the Application Land to the common land register unit CL356 Watering Place opposite Tymparon Hall.

The CRA has given effect to the determination by registering the Application Land as part of common land register unit CL356 which entailed the amendment of the register map and the insertion of an inset map showing the Application Land within the boundary of common land register unit CL356 Watering Place opposite Tymparon Hall.

Reasons

The Committee took into account a report written by the Commons Registration Officer (“the Officer”). The Officer’s report made a recommendation to the Committee to accept the application, on the grounds that there is sufficient evidence that Cumbria County Council as the registration authority made a mistake upon registration under the Commons Registration Act 1965. The Application Land was erroneously not included within the boundary of common land register unit CL356.
