

Commons Act 2006 - Section 19 2(b)
Notice of application to correct the register

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Richard Ridley Brough** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to register unit CL20 Caldbeck Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: Application number 1205 was made on 27th June 1968 (the 1968 Application"). At part 6, the 1968 Application set out the O.S. field numbers to which a right of common was attached as: Matthew Rudding, Caldbeck O.S. no 952, 953, 954, 947, 948, 949, 1080, 1081, 1034, 1036, 1037, 1039, 951, 1021, 958, 946, 955, 1031, 1217, 1216, 1218, 1210.

The Applicant claims that a typographical error in the 1968 Application meant that O.S. 1021 was erroneously recorded in unit CL20 at entry 28 as O.S. 102. Further, the Applicant claims that O.S. no 1031 was mistakenly listed in the 1968 Application and that the correct field number is O.S. 1033. The Applicant seeks by this application to correct the said mistakes.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by substituting O.S.102 for O.S. 1021 and O.S.1031 for 1033.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is 5pm on 9th March.
