Background

Please see attached Proposal which outlines the case.

Legislative Requirements

Section 19(2)(a) specifically allows for a commons registration authority to amend its registers of common land to correct a mistake made by the commons registration authority in making or amending an entry in the register.

The Proposal confirms that the particulars of the land to which the rights are attached, as described in column 5 of entries 47 and 48 of register unit CL189 Bethecar Moor, were transposed when the register was updated in 2012.

Representations

No representations were received.

Decision

The Proposal is approved and entries 47 and 48 of Register Unit CL189 have been deleted and replaced with two new entries, with the particulars of the land now having been assigned to the correct register entries.

A Proposal by Cumbria County Council Section 19 of the Commons Act 2006 Correction of the Register Description of the land transposed to wrong register entries

In accordance with paragraph 18(1) of The Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014 please find below a statement in writing describing the proposal and the justification behind it.

Description of the proposal:

It has become apparent that an error was made by the Commons Registration Authority when updating the commons register for CL189 Bethecar Moor in 2012 to record an apportionment of rights. The particulars of the land to which the rights are attached as described in column 5 of entries 47 and 48 have been transposed, and are therefore currently assigned to the wrong register entries.

Justification for the proposal:

The Commons Registration Authority believe that correcting this mistake, and therefore ensuring the accuracy of the commons register would be in the public interest, particularly as the remaining rights are likely to be apportioned further.

A Proposal by Cumbria County Council Section 19 of the Commons Act 2006 Correction of the Register Description of the land transposed to wrong register entries

Notice is hereby given that a proposal has been made by **Cumbria County Council** ("the Proposer") as the Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The proposal relates to register unit CL189 Bethecar Moor.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: An application for the amendment of register entry 42 to record an apportionment was made on 10th January 2012 ('the 2012 Application'). The 2012 Application resulted in the apportioned rights of 14 sheep or 1 head of cattle or ½ horse being recorded at entry 47, and the remaining rights of 135 sheep or 14 head of cattle or 7 horses being recorded at entry 48. Unfortunately the particulars of the land described in column 5 have been transposed, with the description of the land relating to entry 47 being recorded at entry 48, and vica-versa.

If the proposal is granted the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entries 47 and 48 (making reference to the new corresponding entries), and making two new entries in the register which would have the particulars of the land assigned to the correct register entries.

To determine the proposal it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
