Application to register land at Croft Terrace, Penrith as a town or village green

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: NL0065

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority, has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee ("the Committee") on 23rd August 2018, considered an application to register land at Croft Terrace, Penrith as a new town or village green.

Decision

The Committee resolved to refuse the application, and not add the Application Land to the register of town and village greens.

Reasons

The Committee took into account a report by Commons Officer ("the Officer"). The Officer's report recommended that the Committee refuse the application, on the basis that the statutory criteria to register the Application Land as a town or village green, in accordance with section 15 (2) of the Commons Act 2006 had not been satisfied.

Outcome

The Application Land will not be registered as a village green and the register and legal maps will remain unaltered.
