Adult Social Care Extra Care Housing

Factsheet



Extra Care Housing is a term used to describe a type of sheltered housing property that has a permanent care team located within the building to meet the needs of tenants or homeowners who live there.

Extra care housing schemes offer manageable properties primarily for older people (people over 55) who want to have and maintain their own home but also want flexible and accessible care or support at hand when they need it.

People who live in extra care housing have their own self contained homes with a lounge, kitchen, bedroom and bathroom and access to care staff 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. There are also communal facilities and activities available.



Extra care housing means:

- you live at home, not in a care home;
- you have your own front door and decide who can come in;
- couples can stay together;
- there is a mix of able and less able people;
- 24 hr care and support services available;
- you are supported to keep your independence;
- you can choose whether to join in with on site activities or to stay private;
- you have control over your own finances;
- you have security of tenure.

Extra care housing schemes tend to offer the following:

- private apartments for rent or sale;
- your own front door with letterbox and doorbell;
- various shared facilities like a café or restaurant, lounge, hobbies room, meeting room, library etc, these may vary depending upon the scheme;
- help with housing maintenance;
- care and support delivered to you according to your assessed needs and a support plan agreed with you;
- independent living with flexible support.

If you are thinking about moving, maybe because your current home is too much to manage or doesn't meet your needs and you want to retain your independence and privacy, extra care housing might be an option for you. It can help you to stay as independent as possible and offers a great deal of choice and control over care and support needs.
