PIVATS. (Performance Indicators for Value Added Target Setting)

- A system to inform target setting for pupils of all ages whose performance is outside national expectations.
- A system to complement and work alongside statutory assessment at key stages 1, 2, 3 and 4.
- An approach that may be used annually, as a baseline assessment or as a yearly measurement of added value.
- A tool to support curriculum development, school improvement and self-evaluation.
- A common structure and language for schools and services to judge pupil performance.
- A tool to help with the inclusion of all pupils.
