Commons Act 2006 - Section 19(2)(d) NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Thomas Williamson** ("The Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19(2)(d) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to commons register unit CL70 - Burgh Marsh.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 10 stints (each stint being equal to one beast or 4 sheep or 2 sheep and 4 lambs) on Burgh Marsh comprising the whole of the land in this register unit is currently registered as held in gross at entry 1 of register unit CL70 in the name of the Applicant. The Applicant's address has changed from Glengarry, Kingside Hill, Silloth to Cultram Holme, Main Street, Abbeytown, Wigton. The Applicant seeks by this application to record his new address in the Register.

If the application is granted, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current register entry 1 (making reference to the new corresponding entry) and making the requisite new entry in the register to show the Applicant's new address in column 3.

Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.
