5. Gravel removal/recycling options

Information for flood affected farms in Cumbria - Friday 26 February
Brought to you by all public sector organisations in Cumbria

There are a number of aggregate companies who are able to collect clean stone and gravel for recycling. The details of these companies are highlighted below. We would recommend that farmers make contact with their chosen company directly to negotiate based on their own individual circumstances and indeed requirements. Be reminded that if you may need to use such aggregate for future use then you should retain some on your land. Once the material has gone you will not be given the option to have it returned without significant cost.

Please note this list is not exhaustive. Each of the companies on this list are registered waste carriers and have the necessary permits, registered exempt sites, etc. Other aggregate recycling companies are available through the Yellow Pages. The Lake District National Park Authority (LDNPA) also have a need for clean stone in certain areas to repair footpaths and tracks. Once again, farmers are advised to contact the LDNPA themselves to negotiate arrangements regarding removal and use. If there is a genuine use for stone/gravel within the catchment areas without the need for any treatment then it is not viewed as waste. In these circumstances, those transporting the waste do not need to be registered waste carriers and waste transfer notes are not required.
