

SILVER JUBILEE FUND

The projects should include work of an academic nature connected to industry, service to the community, the arts, sport etc and would normally be taken during the summer vacation.

Successful applicants will receive a small grant or contribution towards travelling expenses as well as an element towards subsistence.

To apply, please write to Student Support Services at the address below, giving details of the applicant's age and the school or college they are attending. The letter should also include an outline of the proposed venture, indicating how and when it will be undertaken, the purpose of the project and the personal and career benefits it is hoped will be achieved.

The closing date for applications is the second week in March – the Trust meets once a year – and applicants who are shortlisted will be asked to attend an interview in April.
