

CUMBRIA MINERALS AND WASTE DEVELOPMENT FRAMEWORK
SUBMISSION DRAFT GENERIC DEVELOPMENT CONTROL POLICIES

Summary

These are the policies that Cumbria County Council is proposing to use for considering planning applications for minerals and waste management developments. They include the criteria and issues that will be taken into account.

The policies set out general criteria for all developments together with separate ones for different waste management developments and for minerals. There are also specific policies about traffic and transport; cumulative impacts; biodiversity and geodiversity; the historic environment; landscape and design; flood risk and water resources; soil resources; after-use and restoration and planning obligations.
