The Government is undertaking a process to identify sites which are suitable or potentially suitable for new nuclear power stations. Sellafield has been nominated by the Nuclear Decommissioning Authority and Braystones and Kirksanton have been nominated by RWE npower. You have one month to comment on these nominations, which we expect to run from 15 April to 14 May 2009. You can see the nominations and criteria that will be used by the Government to assess the sites' suitability and you can comment on the information supplied against the criteria. The Government will incorporate these comments into its assessment of sites.

This is an additional opportunity to comment, in advance of the public consultation in autumn 2009.
