

Consultation on Kirksanton: a potentially suitable site for new nuclear power

The Government is consulting on its draft Nuclear National Policy Statement (NPS) and a list of sites, including Kirksanton, that might be suitable for nuclear power stations.

The draft Nuclear NPS explains the assessment of sites, why new nuclear power is needed, and the Government's policy on managing radioactive waste safely. The NPS will set the framework for planning decisions on new nuclear power stations.
