

Ref 331-LCC0520813 - General Radiologist with an interest in Lower GI, Cross Section, Head and Neck or Paediatric Radiology –this is a replacement post, based at Lancaster Royal Infirmary and requires the post holder to lead and develop Sub speciality Imaging services across the Trust.

Ref 331-LCC0530813 - General Radiologist with an interest in Breast Radiology -is a new post and will join the existing 5 Breast radiologists to support a busy and expanding Breast Service.

Ref 331-BCC0510813 - General Radiologist with a specialist interest - this is a replacement post based at Furness General Hospital. Ideally an interest in nuclear medicine, Chest or Colo-Rectal Imaging would be preferred but other interests will be considered.

You will join an established team of 14 Radiologists across the Trust, in providing a comprehensive diagnostic Imaging and Interventional Service to the population of North Lancashire and South Cumbria. You will be required to contribute to the general workload of the department, including CT, US, MRI and plain film reporting and participate in the on call rota of a maximum of 1 in 16. Nighthawk is used for CT heads between 10 pm and 8 am and personal laptops can be used for tele radiology when on call.

The Radiology department is equipped with GE Centricity PACS, CRIS and benefits from Dragon Voice recognition software systems. The Imaging department is well equipped with 2- 64 slice and 1-16 slice CT scanners, 2 1.5 T MRI, 2 dual head gamma cameras. A Second CT scanner was installed in April 2013 at the RLI. Specialist services include Oncology and Breast, with regional Cardiothoracic and Neurology services being provided at Blackpool and Preston respectively. The department has close links with the Lancashire PETCT Centre based at the Royal Preston Hospital.

The Trust has a keen interest and deep involvement in medical and dental education at both undergraduate and post graduate levels. Medical Students from Lancaster Medical School receive the whole of their education, academic and clinical, in Cumbria and North Lancashire following the Liverpool undergraduate medical curriculum. UHMBT is the lead NHS organisation and takes responsibility throughout the five years of the degree for the provision of acute practice placements and we are a training site for Specialist Registrars in Radiology as part of the Manchester training scheme.
