Time restrictions

You can use the **Cumbria Day Ranger**, **Cumbria Round Robin**, **Cumbrian Coast Day Ranger**, **East Lancashire Day Ranger** and **Lakes Day Ranger** at any time. The **Cheshire Day Ranger**, **Lancashire Day Ranger**, **North West Round Robin** and **South Pennines Day Ranger** tickets are not available for travel on trains timed to depart before 0845 Monday to Friday but are valid at any time during weekends and Bank Holidays. Please note Sunday services are limited on certain routes and there is no Sunday service between Barrow-in-Furness and Whitehaven.

Railcard and child discounts

If conditions of the Railcard are met, holders of 16 – 25, Disabled, Family and Friends and Senior Railcards get a third off the adult fare on all **Day Ranger** and **Round Robin** tickets shown in this guide, except for the **East Lancashire Day Ranger**. Children (5 – 15 years inclusive) travel at half the adult fare. The **East Lancashire Day Ranger** and **Lakes Day Ranger** family versions are available for two adults and up to two children travelling together – two adults can travel together without a child, but no Railcard or child discounts are available.

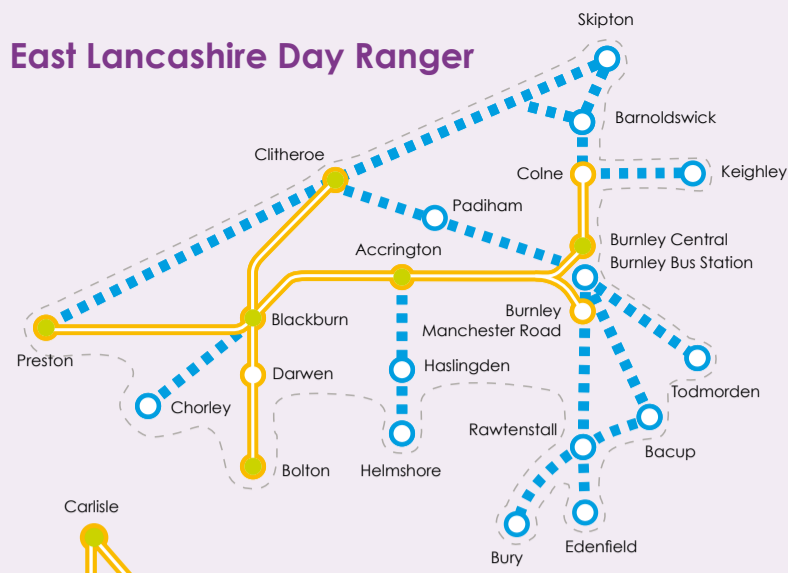

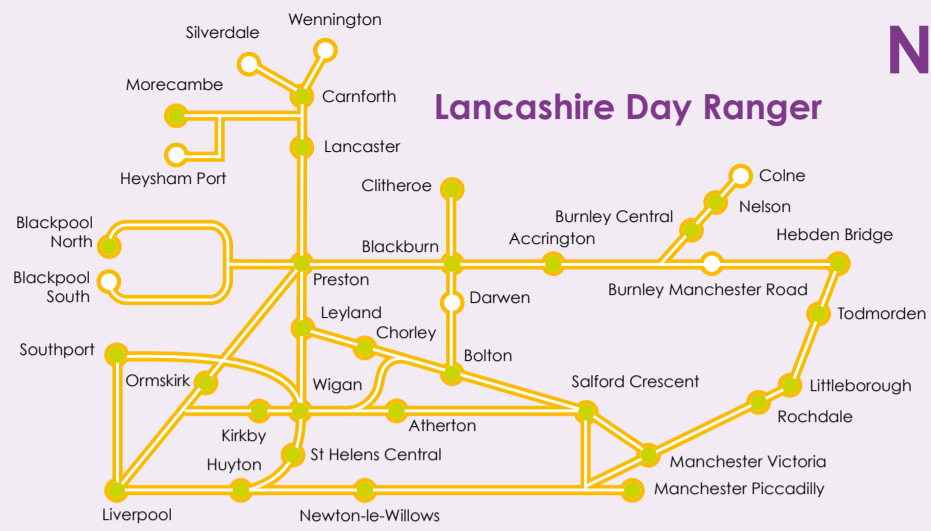

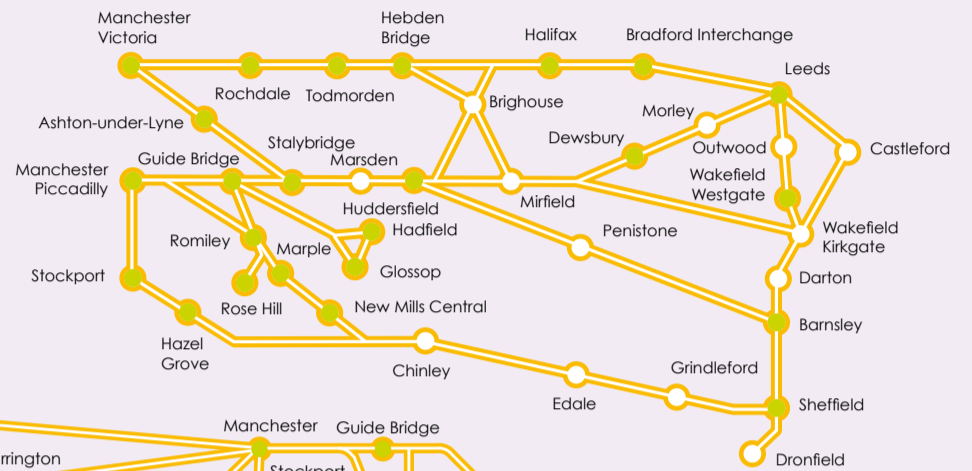
