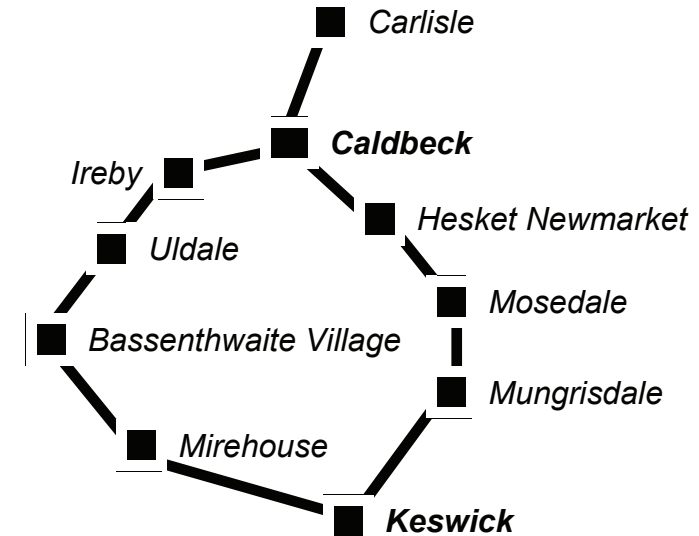

Caldbeck Attractive village with pub, tea room, Priests Mill with waterwheel, craft centre and tea room, village shop, Third World Shop, clogmakers and old map shop.

Hesket Newmarket Picturesque village with pub, shop and tea room.

Mirehouse Historic house and gardens, in beautiful situation, with many literary connections. 'Phone a Tourist Information Centre for details of opening.

Keswick has a wide range of attractions including museums, shops, parks and cruises/boat hire on Derwentwater.

Castlerigg Stone Circle. Ancient site with panoramic views.
