Responding to Welfare Reform - Allerdale summary

This summary provides data and headline analysis about the potential impact of welfare reform in Allerdale:

- There are 6,115 households (14.4%) in Allerdale with an annual income of less than £10,000
- 7,110 people of working age (16-64 years) in Allerdale are claiming some type of benefit; 1 in 4 claimants are aged 45-54years
- 1,125 people are claiming unemployment related Universal Credit
- Youth unemployment rates are above national levels
- Some parts of the district, in particular in deprived, urban areas, have high levels of unemployment
- 808 residents are claiming Universal Credit (numbers are increasing likely reflecting the transition of UC)
- 1 in 5 people living in Allerdale have a long-term health problem or disability, above the county and national average
- During the period October 2010 to March 2015, 2,480 claimants of employment & support allowance/incapacity benefit were re-assessed, of those 14% were deemed 'fit for work' (below national levels).
- 6,110 families are currently claiming child or working tax credits in Allerdale
- 2,770 children (aged 0-19 years) are living in child poverty; levels are below England but levels are high in areas/communities across the district
- Numbers of housing benefit claimants are falling (likely reflecting changes to criteria for young people); 6,535 residents are claiming housing benefit, while 1,300 claimants have received a reduction against the spare room subsidy






