## Responding to Welfare Reform - Eden summary

This summary provides data and headline analysis about the potential impact of welfare reform in Eden:

- 2,909 (12.5%) households in Eden with an annual income of less than £10,000; levels are above the national average
- 2,190 people of working age (16-64 years) in Eden are claiming some type of benefit; most claimants are aged 45-54 years.
- 245 people are claiming unemployment related Universal Credit
- 172 residents are claiming Universal Credit
- 18% of residents in Eden have a long-term health problem or disability, below the national and county average
- During the period October 2010 to March 2015, 780 claimants of employment & support allowance/incapacity benefit were re-assessed, of those 12% were deemed 'fit for work' (below national levels)
- 2,800 families are currently claiming child or working tax credits in Eden (numbers are falling, likely reflecting changes in criteria)
- Levels of child poverty are low in Eden, 7.8% compared to 18% nationally; a total of 760 children (aged 0-19 years) are living in poverty; despite this there are pockets of high levels of child poverty in communities (wards) across the district
- Numbers of housing benefit claimants are falling (likely reflecting changes to criteria); 2,175
  people are claiming housing benefit, while 269 claimants have received a reduction against the
  spare room subsidy






