### **BBC Children in Need**

### **Charity Bank**

Loans to charities and social enterprises of between £50,000 and £2,000,000 for as little as 6 months or as long as 25 years: for building purchase, repair or refurbishment, working capital purposes, the purchase of specialist equipment, short-term bridging needs perhaps pending receipt of grants, stand-by-needs, perhaps to seal a purchase before fundraising comes in. A range of grant funds that are used to invest in communities to bring about a positive and lasting change for the benefit of the whole community. Grant funding is currently available from three separate funds:

- Community Grants - Small grants of usually around £ 1,000 to £ 1,500 or less to contribute towards the set-up of new community initiatives or the purchase of new equipment or refurbishment costs for existing groups
- 0 - 19 Youth Grants - To support projects and initiatives that have a child or youth focus
