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#### WHYP & the 'Tenacity' Sailing Adventure 27<sup>th</sup> August – 3<sup>rd</sup> September 2017

Come sail with us.... WHYP is joining up with the Tall Ship Trust again this summer holiday for another sailing voyage ©

A team of 8 young people & a young leader from West Cumbria (along with WHYP staff member) will have the opportunity to become part of the crew of 'Tenacity' for a week long sea voyage around the West of Scotland coast & islands. The team will travel up together up to Inverkip (Clyde River) to join 'Tenacity' and her crew. After choosing our bunks we will learn about living aboard, be provided with sailing equipment, and prepare to set sail, maybe that evening if the weather is fair. The next 7 days may take us to places such as the Isles of Arran & Bute, the Kintyre peninsula, exploring the dramatic Scottish coastline & sea lochs. The voyage destinations are chosen & planned by the team but will all be dependent upon the weather and crew choice!

The yacht 'Tenacity' or the Tall Ships Ketch is the newest addition to the Tall Ships fleet of 8 yachts. Tenacity is approx. 60ft long yacht that was originally built as part of a GCSE project at Bolton School to celebrate the millennium (but taking 9 years to complete finally setting sail from Glasson Basin, Lancaster, in 2007 to circumnavigate Britain & provides the perfect sail training environment for young people. (Tall Ships Youth Trust)

Tall Ships Trust has been operating for nearly 60 years .... We are experts at teaching people about life on board an ocean-going vessel. We presume you know very little about sailing and will teach you all you need to know. Whether you're in education or need some time off work, all of our voyages are about having fun, new adventures and taking on a challenge. Not only will you learn to sail, you will broaden your horizons and make new friends. Some of our voyages can be mentally and physically challenging, but you will come away with a renewed energy and enthusiasm as well as an experience you will never forget. A Tall Ships Adventure is a unique hands-on experience. You will become an important part of the vessels crew and this involves more than just the sailing – you will also assist in the galley, help maintain the vessel as well as keeping it shipshape.' The total cost for everybody to go will be around £5000, which includes the voyage, travel costs & a residential training/fundraising camp (August). Rather than asking families to dig deep into their pockets to pay a substantial amount, I would like a select team of young people who are motivated to raise money through various events July-Aug. Each person must show commitment to the team by attending regular meetings, (mostly Tuesday evenings) where we will enjoy team challenge activities, and fundraising planning. We will also need to meet at other times to carry out the fundraising activities! It is hoped that the maximum costs to each person will be approximately £160, which can be paid in deposits. But don't let the money costs stop you from applying as we may be able to find funds to sponsor you.

The preparation & voyage allows participants to achieve an RYA Crewing Certificate whilst away sailing, this may lead on to other sailing opportunities. The fundraising could fulfil the volunteering section of the Duke of Edinburgh's Award Scheme together with completing the residential section of Gold whilst on board.
