

‘Charlie’s Bridge’



Recently, Cumbria County Council has completed a new bridle bridge over the River Wampool at Kirkbride. Local demand has led to the new bridge that provides a useful link to the local network of paths. This is the second project that has been run in partnership with the Parish Council to develop and improve the public rights of way in the parish. The first saw the surfacing and drainage of routes to the South of the village and was made possible, like this one with the support of the local landowners.
