Sessions open to all Members

- **Understanding Full Council:** The session will give Members an understanding of how Full Council operates, and will cover rules of debate, motions and questions.
- Code of Conduct and Equalities: The session will give Members an understanding of the Member Code of Conduct, the Council's Fraud and Anti-Corruption policies, and the Council's policies and duties in relation to equality and anti-discrimination.
- **Corporate Parenting:** This session will give Members an understanding of their responsibilities as the Corporate Parents of all children and young people from Cumbria who are in care and care leavers.
- **Digital by Choice:** This session will provide Members with insight into the Council's digital approach to the delivery of services and how they can support people in their divisions to access services in this way.
- **ICT Training:** Morning sessions will show Members how to make the best use of their Laptops/Tablets. Afternoon sessions will look at how to make best use of Windows Phones (Members can attend any session anywhere in the county).
- **Health and Safety:** This session will give Members an understanding of their responsibilities under Health and Safety legislation (Members only need attend one of the sessions).
- Introduction to Highways: This session will give Members an understanding of the Council's highways
 responsibilities and how to support members of the public with queries about highways (Members only
 need attend one of the sessions).
- **Fire and Rescue Taster Day:** This session will give Members an opportunity to learn more about the Council's Fire and Rescue Service, including the role of the Resilience Unit.

Sessions for Members on statutory committees

All Members who sit on a committee are required to attend a training session before the committee meets for the first time. A short pre-committee induction session on the day on the day of the committee will also take place to brief Members of procedural matters. This applies to:
