

Barrow-in-Furness

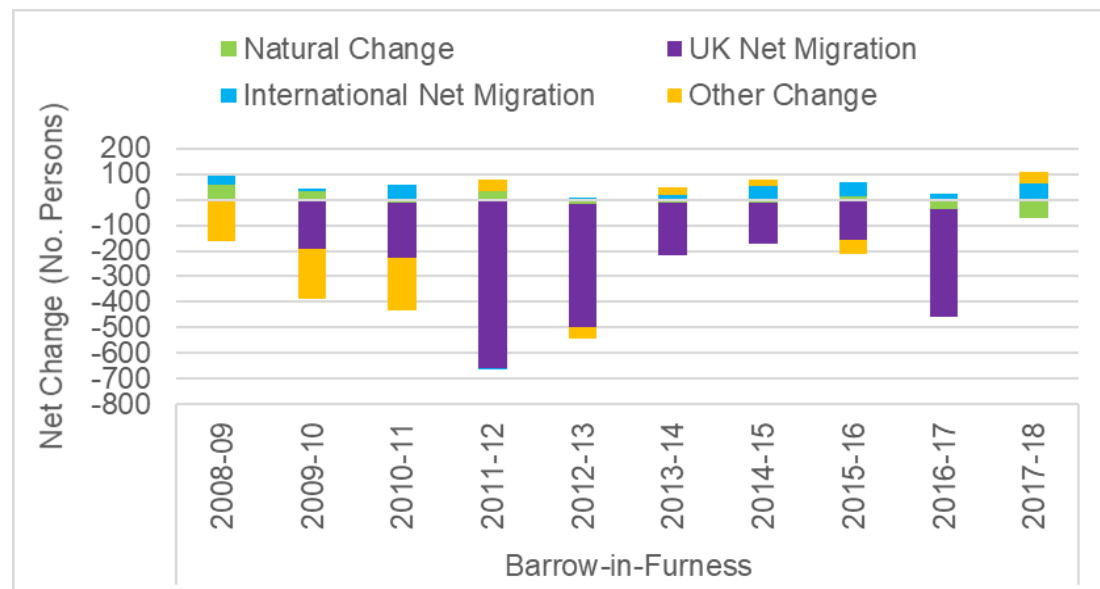
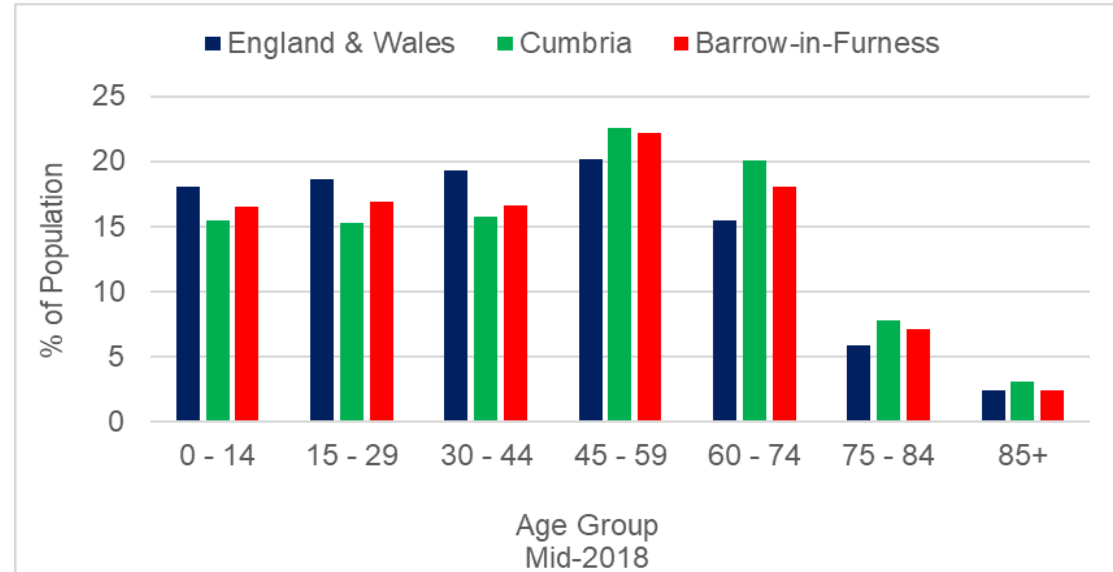
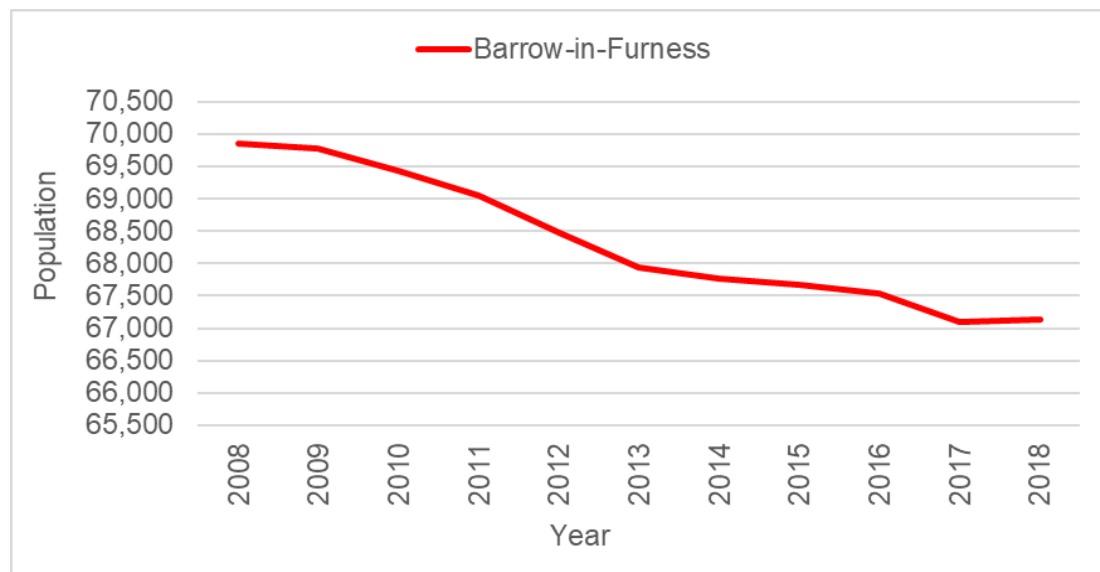
At Mid-2016 Barrow-in-Furness's population was estimated to be 67,100;

When compared to England & Wales, Barrow-in-Furness has lower proportions of residents in the three youngest age groups (0-44 years), higher proportions of residents in the 45-84 age groups, and a similar proportion of residents in the oldest age group (aged 85+);

Since Mid-2017, the population of Barrow-in-Furness has increased very slightly (+0.1%) The greatest percentage increase occurred in the 75 - 84 age group (+4.2%) and the greatest percentage decrease occurred in the 15 - 29 age group (-1.3%);

Since Mid-2017, there have been more deaths than births in Barrow-in-Furness, this 'natural change' has accounted for a decrease of 100 persons across the district. During the same time, 100 more people have migrated into Barrow-in-Furness (from other parts of the UK and overseas) than have migrated out of Barrow-in-Furness.
