

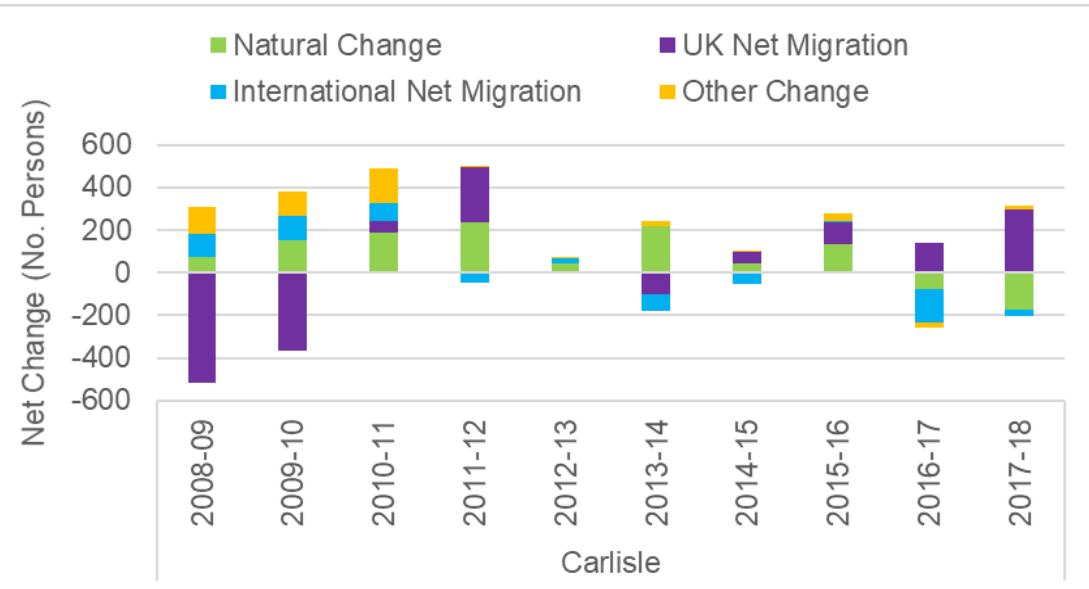
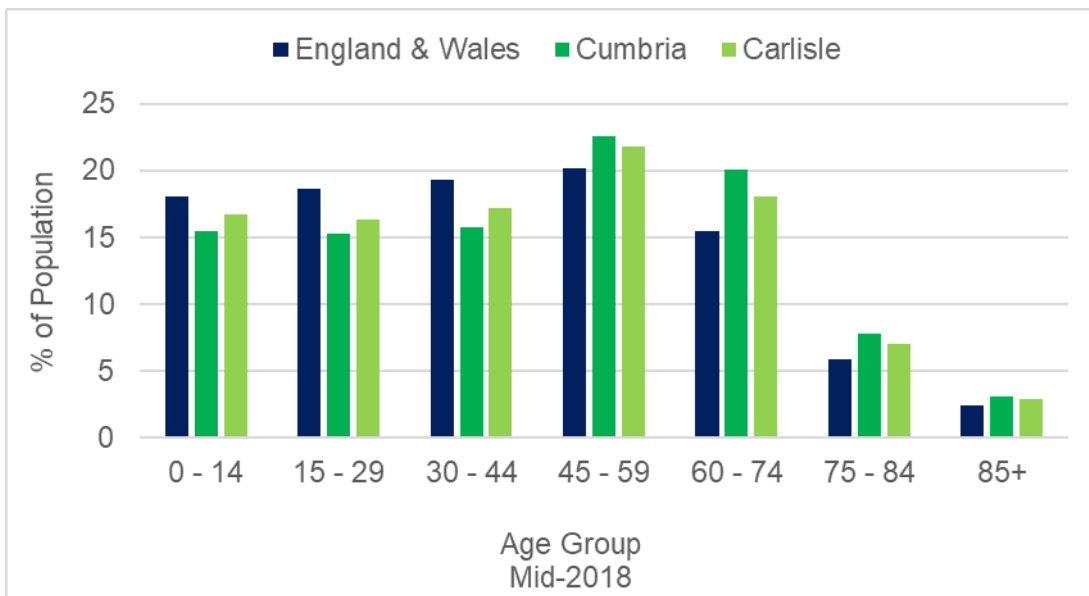
At Mid-2018 Carlisle's population was estimated to be 108,400;

When compared to England & Wales, Carlisle has lower proportions of residents in the three youngest age groups (0-44 years) and higher proportions of residents in the four oldest age groups (aged 45+);

Since Mid-2017, the population of Carlisle has increased by 100 people (+0.1%), with the greatest percentage increase occurring in the 85+ age group (+2.2%) and the greatest percentage decrease occurring in the 15 - 29 age group (-1.4%);

Since Mid-2017, there have been more deaths than births in Carlisle, this 'natural change' has accounted for a decrease of 200 persons across the district. Furthermore, during the same time, 300 more people have migrated into Carlisle (from other parts of the UK and overseas) than have migrated out from Carlisle.
