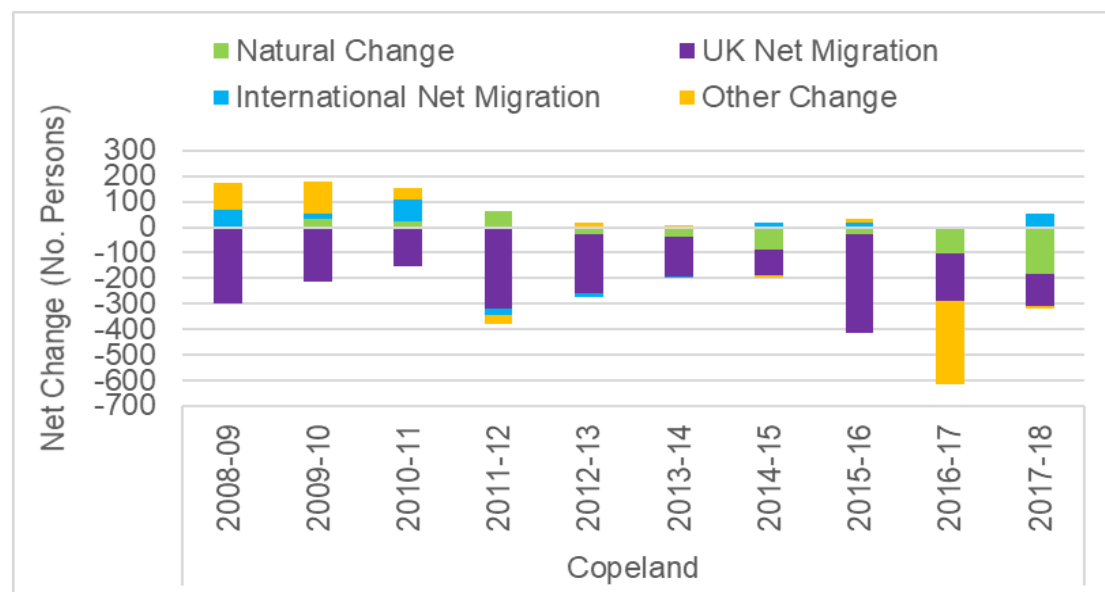
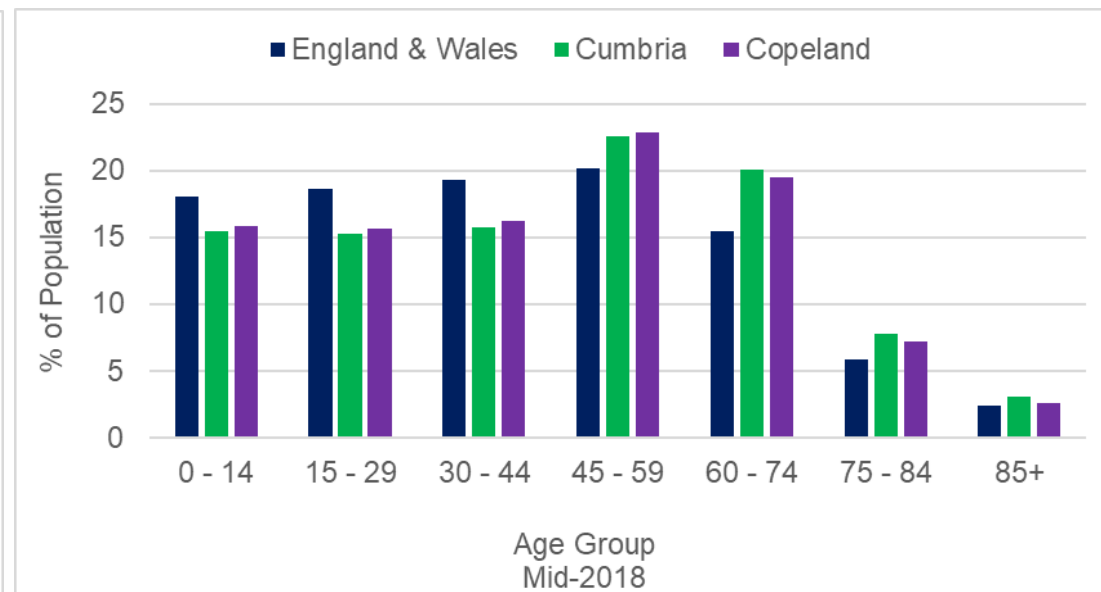
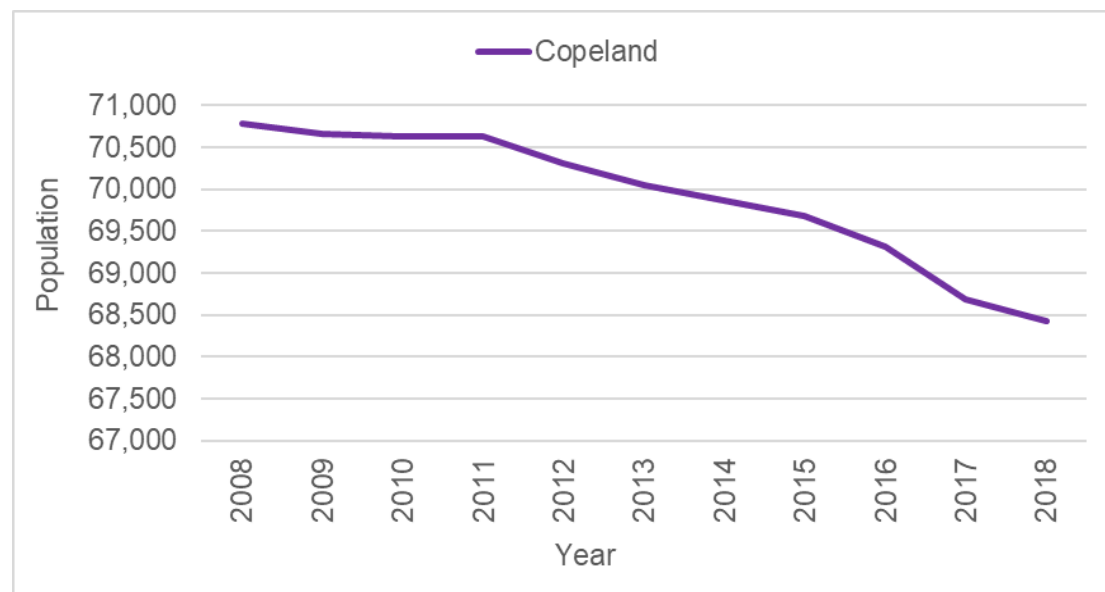
At Mid-2018 Copeland's population was estimated to be 68,400;

When compared to England & Wales, Copeland has lower proportions of residents in the three youngest age groups (0-44 years) and higher proportions of residents in the four oldest age groups (aged 45+);

Since Mid-2017, the population of Copeland has decreased by 300 people (-0.4%). The greatest percentage increase occurred in the 60 – 74 age group (+1.6%) and the greatest percentage decrease occurred in the 15 - 29 age group (-1.3%);

Since Mid-2017, there have been more deaths than births in Copeland, this 'natural change' has accounted for a decrease of 200 persons across the district. During the same time, 100 more people have migrated out of Copeland (to other parts of the UK and overseas) than have migrated into Copeland.
