

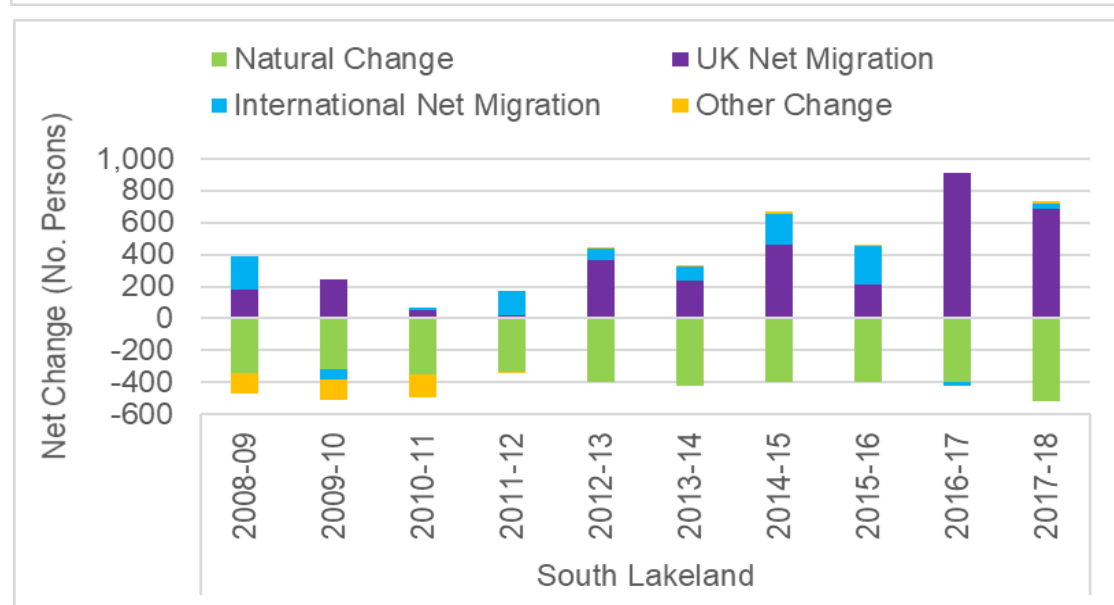
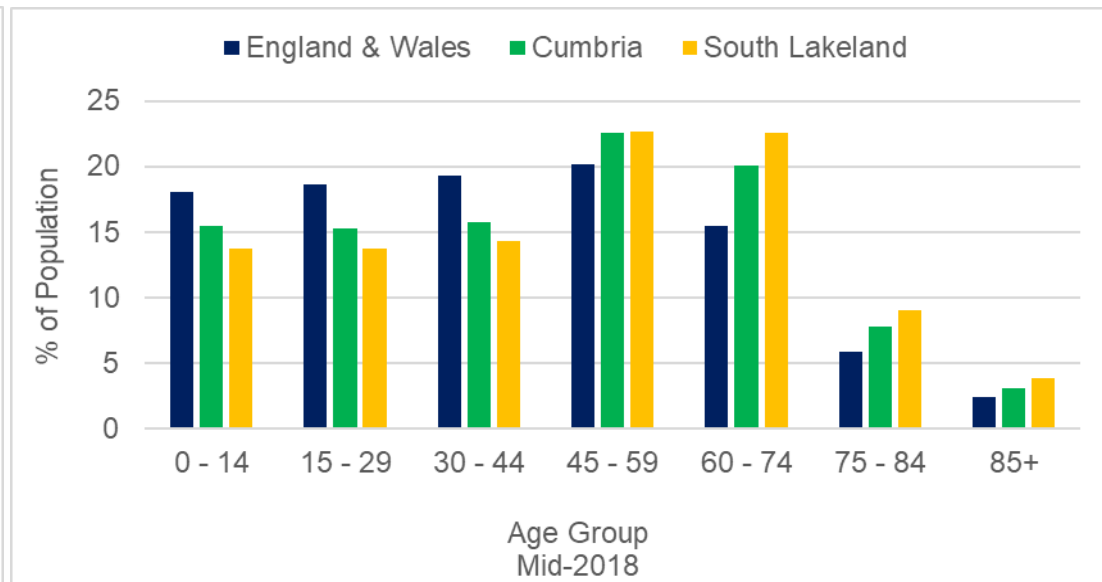
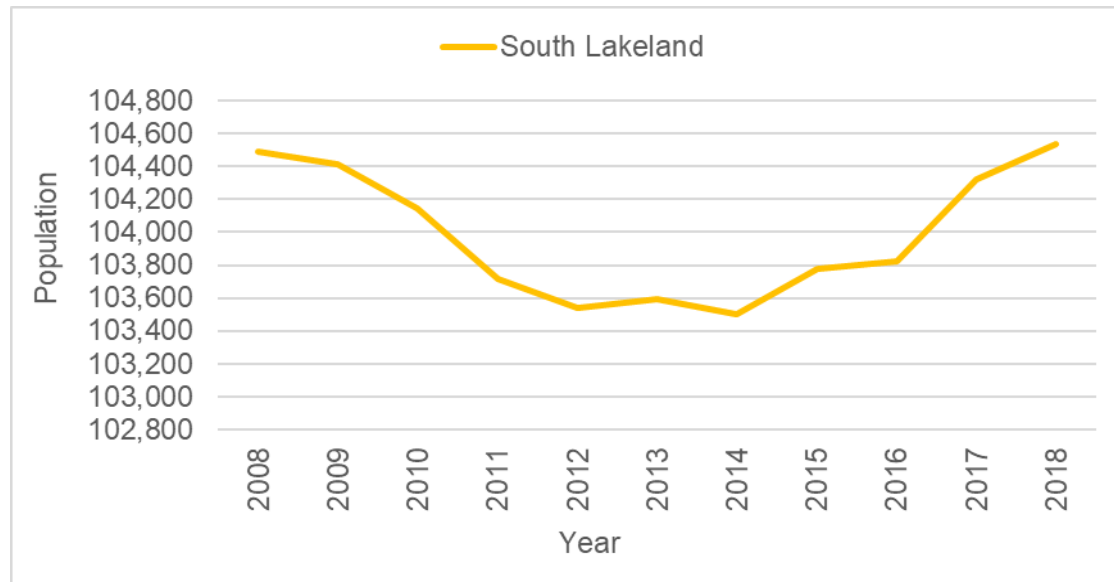
At Mid-2018 South Lakeland's population was estimated to be 104,500;

When compared to England & Wales, South Lakeland has lower proportions of residents in the three youngest age groups (0-44 years) and higher proportions of residents in the four oldest age groups (aged 45+);

Since Mid-2017, the population of South Lakeland has increased by 200 people (+0.2%), with the greatest percentage increase occurring in the 75 - 84 age group (+3%) and the greatest percentage decrease occurring in the 30-44 age group (-0.6%);

Since Mid-2017, there have been more deaths than births in South Lakeland, this 'natural change' has accounted for a decrease of 500 persons across the district. During the same time, 700 more people have migrated into South Lakeland (from other parts of the UK and overseas) than have migrated out from South Lakeland.
