

A programme for parents of children with a diagnosis of Autism

Aims of the Programme:

- To help parents to understand their child's autism by getting into 'their world' to develop interaction and communication
- To support parents at the earliest opportunity to pre-empt the development of inappropriate behaviours
- To create a support network of peers who may be able to share problems, experiences and solutions in parenting a young child with autism.

Who is it for?

The programme is for families of pre-school age (up to age of 5) children with a diagnosis of autism.

The NAS EarlyBird Programme runs over 12 weeks and involves parents in a weekly commitment to two and a half hour sessions.

Two parent/ carers can attend from each family with a maximum of 10 families.
