Key Holder Responsibilities

Wi-Fi

Public Wi-fi is available at our Hawse End Centre main house, Hawse End Cottage and our campsite at Scarness. An access code can be provided on request.

Wi-fi is also available at our Fellside Centre where a code can be provided for access on request.



Tuck Shop

We have an on-site tuckshop available to use at both Hawse End and Fellside. Cumbria Outdoors can run/open this on request during office hours or your host can show you how to operate the till to run/open it yourselves, after office hours. As a guide, items such as pens, highlighters and torches are on sale for £1 - £1.50, notepads £2 and teddy bear key rings £3.50. Chocolate, sweets and drinks are also available.
