

Finding procedures from the menu



Procedures are divided amongst four categories:

Core Procedures (what to do) e.g. Thresholds, Child Protection, Allegations Against Staff or Volunteers etc

Safeguarding Practice Guidance e.g. Bullying, Domestic Abuse, Child Sexual Exploitation etc

Learning and Improvement Learning and Improvement Strategy, Serious Case Reviews, CDOP etc

Safeguarding Partnership Arrangements inc. Conflict Resolution Policy and Guidance for Safe Recruitment etc



Finding procedures using the search


Enter clear terms like 'domestic abuse', 'LADO' and 'sexual exploitation' to find relevant procedures.
