Course Aim:
This course deals with the context of child protection and how it is everybody's responsibility to keep children safe. The different signs and types of abuse are described, as are the ways to keep children you work with safe.


Course Objectives:
It outlines the importance of child protection and how everyone can keep children safe from abuse. It also helps learners recognise the signs and types of abuse, including some less common types of abuse such as trafficking, forced marriage, and female genital mutilation.
On completion, you will have learnt how to recognise when a child may be suffering from abuse and what you can do to keep children safe.
A multiple choice knowledge check is included.

Target Audience:
All professionals working with children, or who are in contact with children, have a role and duty in safeguarding children from harm.
This course is suitable for everyone who works directly with children and young people in Cumbria, including front line professionals.
This course covers a variety of safeguarding children and child protection issues and is suitable for anyone who regularly comes into contact with children, including front line practitioners.
This should be covered in the induction phase and within first six months of employment and either 2 or 2 yearly thereafter.

Which training is right for me?
It must be remembered that individual agencies remain responsible for ensuring that their staff are competent and confident to carry out their roles safely including their safeguarding children responsibilities. All staff should receive appropriate safeguarding and child protection training which is regularly updated. In addition, all staff should receive safeguarding and child protection updates (for example, via email, e-bulletins and staff meetings), as required, to provide them with relevant skills and knowledge to safeguard children effectively.
While the Cumbria Safeguarding Children's Partnership (CSCP) recommend staff attend safeguarding training every 3 years as a minimum, some statutory guidance (for example from the Department for Education) may insist on more frequent attendance (e.g. Designated Safeguarding Leads for Schools should update safeguarding training every 2 years).

Frequently asked questions

1. Can I stop working through an eLearning course and return to it later?

A benefit of My Learning is that you don't have to complete a whole course in one visit. You can revisit a course as many times as you like in order to complete it. Course duration obviously depends on the size of the course and the sections within it. We recommend spending no more than 1½ hours in each eLearning session you do.

To exit a course at any time, click on **Home**, located in the bottom of every page, which will take you back to the course contents. Click on **Exit**, to leave the course and return to the **Course Homepage**. Your eLearning course and completed sections will be saved in your profile and will be available the next time you log in.

2. How do I know if I have completed a section within an eLearning course?

While working through the course a blue bar will move from left to right across the top of the screen, Once this bar reaches the right hand side the section is complete.

You can click on this bar to show the progress of each stage, if any of the sections are white they are incomplete. You can click or tap on these sections to move back and complete them.

3. How can I find out which eLearning courses I have completed?

Click or tap on Records of Learning on the toolbar at the top of the page, you will then see a list of eLearning courses you have accessed or completed. If they are complete this will show a green bar next to the course title.
