

**Commons Act 2006 – Schedule 3  
NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO AMEND THE REGISTER TO RECORD AN HISTORIC EVENT**

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Robert Isaak Cookson and Janice Diane Cookson** (“the Applicants”) to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register CL3 Martindale Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 600 sheep over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit was registered as attached to Cote Farm, Howtown, Penrith at entry 7 of register unit CL3 in the name of William Hugh Parkin. Entry 7 was cancelled and replaced by entries 25 and 26 pursuant to application number 625 dated 13<sup>th</sup> December 1999 by Jaqueline and David Baldrey who, under the terms of a Transfer, dated 1<sup>st</sup> November 1999 acquired the whole of the land listed in column 5 of entry 7 together with a right to graze 475 sheep. The Applicants claim that the remaining right to graze 125 sheep (“the Right”) was severed from the land and transferred to them under the terms of a Transfer dated 1<sup>st</sup> November 1999. The Applicants seek by this application to have that severance recorded in the register.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entry 26 (making reference to the new corresponding entry) and making a new entry in the register to show the Right as severed and held in gross.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA14/20**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person’s interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on 3<sup>rd</sup> March 2017.
