**Application to amend the register to record an historic event– historic severance of a right of common.**

**NOTICE OF DETERMINATION**

**Application Number: CA14/19**

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, as the Commons Registration Authority (“the CRA”), has considered an application submitted by the Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food now known as Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs (“the Applicant”) to amend the register to record an historic severance of a right of common concerning the right to graze 18 geese and the right to water 38 cattle in Scalderskew Beck and to graze them on Ponsonby Fell when exercising the right to water comprising the whole of the land in this register unit which was registered as attached to the land and estate at Scalderskew in the Parish of St Bridgets at entry 2 of register unit CL165 Ponsonby Fell (“the Right”).

**Decision**


The CRA resolved to accept the application to amend the register by registering the severance of the proportion of the Right which was attached to land shown coloured red on the attached map.

**Reasons**

The Commons Registration Officer assessed the application and found it to be duly made under the criteria prescribed by the relevant regulations and guidance.

The register for CL165 Ponsonby Fell has been amended to show the proportion of the Right attached to land shown coloured red on the attached map as severed from that land and held in gross and the remainder of the Right as attached to the rest of the dominant tenement.
