Discover how Wainwright wrote his guide books



Children will investigate the archive to work out how Alfred created his books in this 2 hour workshop. They then develop their drawing skills by making their own Wainwright drawing and understand the mastery of his techniques by using a dip pen and ink.

This workshop uses a range primary sources from Wainwright's archive. Storytelling and drama are incorporated into the workshop to help bring the evidence to life in a fun and lively session.

- Gain skills in using historical evidence.
- Understand how archives provide evidence about Wainwright's life and techniques he used to create his books.
- Develop landscape drawing skills.
- Understand the methods and approaches Wainwright used to record the landscape.
- Develop drawing skills using his style and equipment.
- Understand continuity and change.
