Free face-to-face or online help (via Google Meet) with debt through award-winning debt counselling. Our Service is free and available to all individuals.

CAP's debt help service is specifically tailored to help financially and socially disadvantaged people. Geared to accommodate those with complex needs, the combination of one-to-one appointments, a befriending service and in-depth counselling empowers individuals to break free from credit dependency and work their way out of debt. 91% of people who used CAP's debt help service described it as 'life-transforming' or 'a great help'.

The service includes budgeting, specialist advice, creditor negotiation, a full insolvency service and Debt Management Plans.
