1. Emergency

1. Nightstop (emergency provision). Nightstop Cumbria offers accommodation for young people in immediate housing crisis in the homes of trained and approved volunteer 'hosts'. Placements are dependent on a satisfactory Risk Assessment and offered on a night by night basis.

2. Homestay is a County Council run supported lodgings scheme, with people offering a young person a room in their home and support to enable them to develop independent living skills on a respite basis. Homestays can also offer support to young people in their homes.

3. Miller Court, Kendal: 6 x 1 bed flats (Impact Housing).

4. South Lakes Foyer: Stage 1:

Supported temporary accommodation (STA) (16-25) -6 Flats. **Stage 2** STA (18-25) up to 2yrs -6 flats.
