

Adult Learning are a committed team of educators and specialists that aim to provide an accessible and positive learning experience for all learners. We know each learner thinks and learns in a different way so a tailored & personalised approach, based on your individual needs, can have a transformative impact on your learning.

Do you feel you think or learn in a unique way or need support throughout your learning journey? Roughly 30% of the working-age population do, that's about 1 in 3 people! ENGLISH AND MATHS

Adult Learning's Functional English and maths courses can be delivered face-to-face or online, across a range of qualification levels.

DID YOU KNOW

It typically takes 54 to 120 hours to achieve a level in English or maths.

The team at your local Adult Learning centre can provide quality advice and guidance that will help you in getting on the right course by:

- Helping you to complete your BKSB initial assessment
- The information from the assessment will be used to provide you with your starting point and your qualification goal.
- All initial and diagnostic assessments, even for online classes, will take
 place at one of our Adult Learning centres or can be sent to your home to
 complete.

DURING YOUR COURSE YOU WILL HAVE ACCESS TO:

- Diagnostic assessment which will inform your skills scan
- Weekly Zoom classes (for online classes) or face-to-face taught sessions with your tutors and your peers
- Individual feedback and reviews to help you to track your progress
- Access to online learning resources (Mymaths and / or Educake)
- Mock exam sessions
- CGP book to support your learning
- Adult Learning Support (where applicable)

Once you have completed your initial assessment, the centre team will discuss which course and level is appropriate based on your results, when and where classes are available for you to start you learning journey.

Remember: To achieve it is important that you attend your classes as poor attendance and punctuality may result in you being withdrawn from the course.

Also: Exams will be held in your local centre and not online even for those learning via Zoom. Information about the exams will be discussed and confirmed prior to taking place.

We enrol learners at regular intervals throughout the year, so if you decide to study maths and English later in the year, you can still join classes up until Easter. However, it is important that you leave enough time to achieve your desired qualification before the end of the academic year.

GCSE MATHS AND ENGLISH

We also offer GCSEs in both English and maths, starting in September. With initial and diagnostic assessments already taking place in your local centre, book yours now to ensure you are on the right course for your individual needs.
