

## **GOVERNING BODY OF ARNSIDE NATIONAL C OF E SCHOOL**

Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that The governing body of Arnside National C of E School, (Voluntary Aided), intends to make a prescribed alteration to Arnside National C of E School, Church Hill, Arnside, Carnforth, Lancashire LA5 0DW from 01 September 2011.

The governing body of Arnside National C of E School would like to provide maintained nursery education at the school for 24 pupils aged 3 and 4. The effect of the proposal will be to change the age range of the school from 4–11 to 3–11.

The proposed alteration will make provision for 0 full time nursery pupils and 24 part time nursery pupils.

The current capacity of the school is 168 and the proposed capacity will be 168. The current admission number for the school is 24 and the proposed admission number will be 24.

The governing body will implement the proposal.

### **Explanatory Notes**

1. The Governors of Arnside National School are proposing to make a prescribed alteration to the school by extending the age range to allow the provision of nursery education.
2. The nursery will be accommodated in the existing school buildings and will provide for up to 24 places at each session operating initially for 3 hours each morning for 5 sessions per week.
3. Admission to the nursery will be in accordance with the Governors published policy on nursery admissions.
4. Admission to the nursery does not guarantee a place in the first year infant group i.e. the reception group. The Governors' admissions policy as amended from time to time will apply for admission to the reception group to which up to 24 pupils will be admitted in September 2011. That is also the number that it is anticipated will be available in the other year groups.
