

## PROPOSAL TO CLOSE BRAM LONGSTAFFE NURSERY SCHOOL

Notice is given in accordance with section 15(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Cumbria County Council intends to discontinue Bram Longstaffe Nursery School, Farm Street, Barrow-in-Furness, LA14 2RX on 31 August 2020. Following an Ofsted inspection in December 2019 the nursery has the lowest Ofsted rating of 'Special Measures'.
