Notice is given in accordance with section 19(3) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that The Governing Body of Grasmere CE School intends to make a prescribed alteration to Grasmere Church of England Voluntary Aided Primary School, Stock Lane, Grasmere, Cumbria LA22 9SJ from 1 September 2010.

The Governing Body of Grasmere CE School would like to provide maintained nursery education at the school for pupils aged 3 and 4. The effect of the proposal will be to change the age range of the school from 4–11 to 3–11.

The proposed alteration will make provision for 0 full time nursery pupils and 8 part time nursery pupils.

The current capacity of the school is 56 and the proposed capacity will be 56. The current admission number for the school is 8 and the proposed admission number will be 8.

The governing body will implement the proposal.

Explanatory Notes

1. The Governors of Grasmere School are proposing to make a prescribed alteration to the school by extending the age range to allow the provision of nursery education.
2. The nursery will be accommodated in the existing school buildings and will provide for up to 8 places. The nursery would operate flexibly each day (Monday to Friday) during term time. Each session will usually last 3 hours. Parents will be allowed to access, free of charge, up to 15 hours each week (5 three hour sessions).
3. Admission to the nursery will be in accordance with the school's published policy on nursery admissions.
4. Admission to the nursery does not guarantee a place in the first year infant group i.e. the reception group. The Governor's admissions policy as amended from time to time will apply for admission to the reception group to which up to 8 pupils will be admitted in September 2010. That is also the number that it is anticipated will be available in the other year groups.
