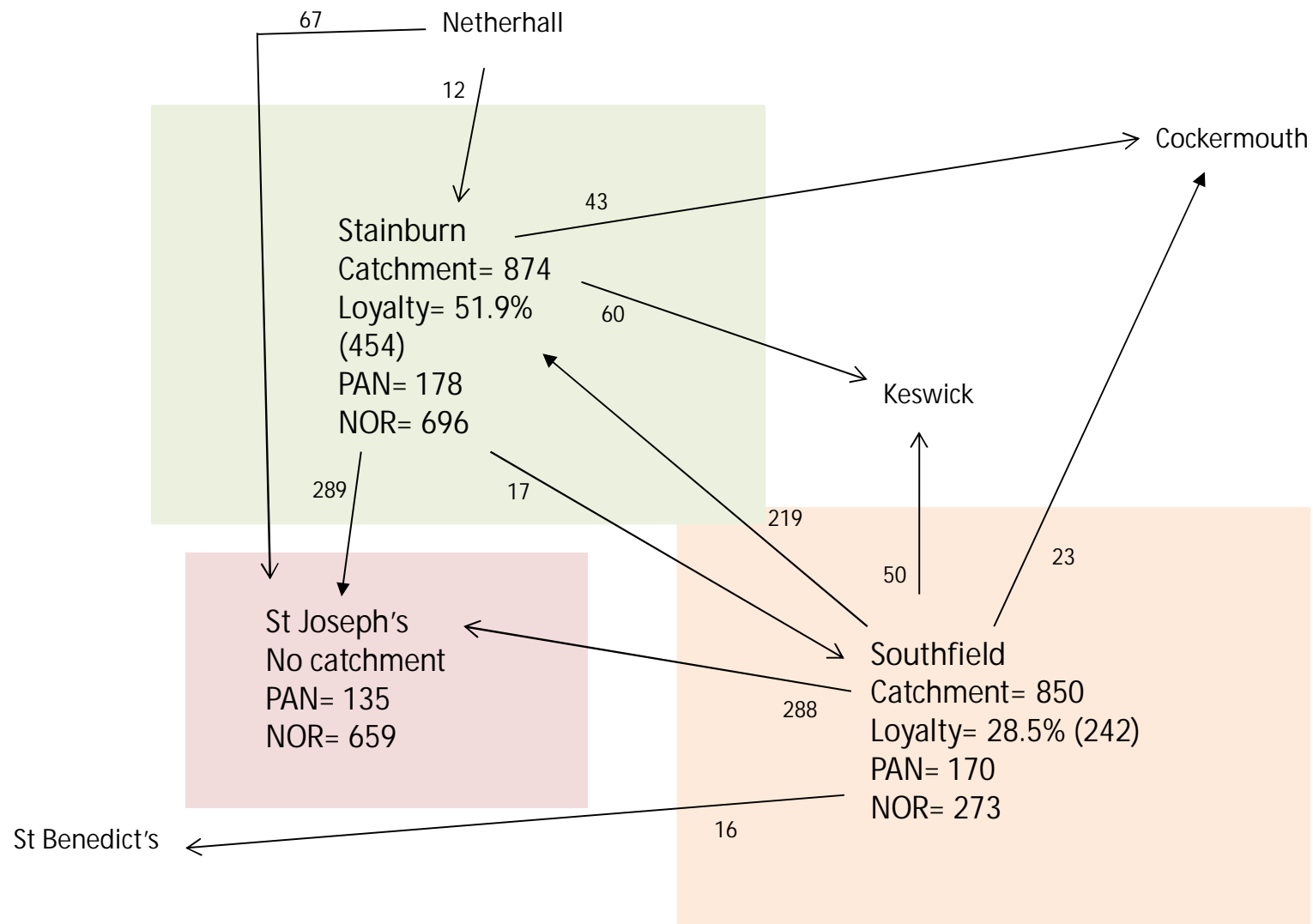


Southfield, Stainburn & St Joseph's Schools 11-16 year olds



Notes on School Loyalty Maps

- All maps are compiled using data taken from the ONE system after the commencement of the current academic year, Sept 2013
- Arrows between schools denote movement in to or out of a school catchment area. Figures by the arrows are whole school totals, ie. all age groups added together
- The details below a school name are
 - Catchment – the number of school aged children in a catchment area
 - Loyalty – a percentage showing how many of the children stay within the catchment area to attend school (the actual number is shown in brackets)
 - PAN – the school Published Admission Number (this is the number of pupil places available in Year 7)
 - A Roman Catholic school will only display a PAN as they have no defined catchment areas
 - NOR – Number on roll is the amount of pupils in the school as taken from the October 2013 census
- The actual geographical relationship of schools is only approximately represented in order to accommodate the display of information
- Coloured areas do not represent school catchment areas
- Schools outside the 'cluster' may be included on the loyalty map in order to present a realistic picture of all movement within the area
- Maps may show only movement over a certain number of pupils to avoid an over cluttered diagram
- Loyalty maps for secondary schools use 11-16 data only - sixth forms are not included
