Notice is given in accordance with section 19(1) of the Education and Inspections Act 2006 that Cumbria County Council, School Organisation Team, Parkhouse Building, Lower East Wing, Kingmoor Business Park, Carlisle, Cumbria. CA6 4SJ intends to make a prescribed alteration to St Catherine's Catholic Primary School (Voluntary Aided), Drovers Lane, Penrith, Cumbria CA11 9EL from 01 September 2012 and 31 December 2012.

Cumbria County Council is proposing that the Published Admission Number should increase from 15 to 20 from 01 September 2012 and to enlarge the school by building appropriate additional facilities on 31 December 2012.

The school will gradually increase its maximum capacity by accepting reception intakes of up to 20 pupils each year from 1st September 2012. The higher year groups already on roll at the school will not increase in size.

The current capacity of the school is 105 and the proposed capacity will be 140. The current number of pupils registered at the school is 115. The current admission number for the school is 15 and the proposed admission number will be 20.

No new site or additional site is required for this proposal.

In the opinion of the local authority there are no other related proposals which have been or are about to be published.

The proposal is to be implemented by the local authority.
