Application to amend the register to record an historic event

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Michael Harrison** ("the Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, concerning the right on CL26 Skinburness and Calvo Marshes described more fully below.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 7 stints (one stint being equal to one beast, or 4 sheep, or two sheep and four lambs) on Skinburness and Calvo Marshes comprising the whole of the land in this register unit ("the Right"), is currently registered as not attached (held in gross) at Entry 5 of register unit CL26, in the name of Joseph Stansfield Harrison of "Byland", Marsh Farm, Skinburness, Silloth, Cumbria. By Deed of Gift dated 1 st February 1994, Joseph Stansfield Harrison gifted the Right to his son, Malcolm Harrison. Subsequently the Right was assented to the Applicant upon the death of Malcolm Harrison, by way of Assent dated 24 september 2008. The aforementioned Deed of Gift and Assent do not operate at law to transfer ownership of the Right until registered by the Commons Registration Authority in the register. The Applicant seeks by this application to complete the transfer of ownership and register the Right in his own name.

If the application is granted, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by amending the register to show the Applicant as the owner of the Right.

- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Representations will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received from you to others, which may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). A copy of any correspondence may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is 3rd September 2015.
