Application to correct the register – mistake made by the registration authority.

NOTICE OF DETERMINATION

Application Number: CA10/2

Notice is hereby given that Cumbria County Council, acting as Commons Registration Authority ("the CRA"), has at a meeting of its Development Control and Regulation Committee ("the Committee") on 07 October 2015, considered an application to correct a mistake in the register concerning registration of land at Seat Howe Villa, Thornthwaite (herein after referred to as "the Application Land) as Common Land.

**Decision**

The Committee resolved to accept the application to correct the register and remove the Application Land from the Common Land Register Unit No. CL260 Beckstones Beck, Nr Keswick.

**Reasons**

The Committee took into account a report of the Commons Registration Officer ("the Officer"), which assessed the relevant evidence and made a recommendation to the Committee to accept the application; the Officer's report concluded that the CRA made a mistake upon registration under the Commons Registration Act 1965, the Application Land was incorrectly registered as Common Land and that the relevant criteria to grant the application had been met.

The Committee, on considering the Officer's report, resolved to approve the Officer's recommendation to grant the application and remove the Application Land from the register of Common Land.
