Application to correct mistaken registration

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by Peter Mark Cawson and Julia Louise Cawson ("the Applicants") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, relating to land at Bridge House, Murton (hereinafter referred to as "the Application Land" coloured red on the attached plan).

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: Application No. 62 was submitted to the Commons Registration Authority by the Clerk of Murton Parish Council on 10th October 1967. The Commons Registration Authority provisionally registered parcels of land as VG7 on 22nd November 1967 (coloured green on the attached plan), being undisputed the registration became final on 1st October 1970. The Applicants claim that the Application Land was mistakenly registered, the Application Land has never been Village Green and that the Application Land has at all material times been within the curtilage of the building known as Bridge House. The Applicants request the land to be deregistered; this would result in the removal of the Application Land from the register unit VG7 Murton Village Green.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by preparing a fresh edition of the register map showing the removal of the Application Land from the registered Village Green VG7.

Representations:

- must quote the Application No. CA13/4
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). A copy of any correspondence may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is 4th November 2015.
