

Commons Act 2006 - Section 8

Application for apportionment of rights of common

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Mr Philip Wilson** ("The Applicant") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 8 of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014. The application relates to entry number 6 of the common land register unit CL33 – Ravenstonedale Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The following right is attached to Wath Farm, Newbiggin-on-Lune comprising O.S. field numbers 79, 80, 80a, 85, 86, 87, 90, 91, 93, 96, 97, 100, 103, 105, 109 and 156 on the O.S. Map (Edition of 1915) and is exercisable over the whole of the land in register unit CL33 – Ravenstonedale Common:

"The right to graze: (a) 120 ewes with their followers and (b) 40 hogs" (The Right").

Pursuant to the division of the land to which the Right are attached, the Applicant seeks by his application to register apportionment of the Right appropriate to the parts of land transferred and now in his ownership.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by making the following amendment to the commons register:

1. Entry number 6 will be deleted.
2. Addition of two supplemental maps.
3. The following entries will be made to the rights section of the commons register to show the proportionate apportionment of the Right to the Applicant (i) and the remainder of the Right (ii):
 - (i) To graze (a) 5.19 ewes and their followers and (b) 1.73 hogs over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit. The right is attached to O.S. field number 97 shown coloured blue on the supplemental map; and
 - (ii) To graze (a) 114.1 ewes and their followers and (b) 38.27 hogs over the whole of the land comprised in this register unit. The right is attached to O.S field numbers 79, 80, 80a, 85, 86, 87, 90, 91, 93, 96, 100, 103, 105, 109 and 156 shown coloured pink on the proposed supplemental map.

Representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA3/4**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the commons registration authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may also be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

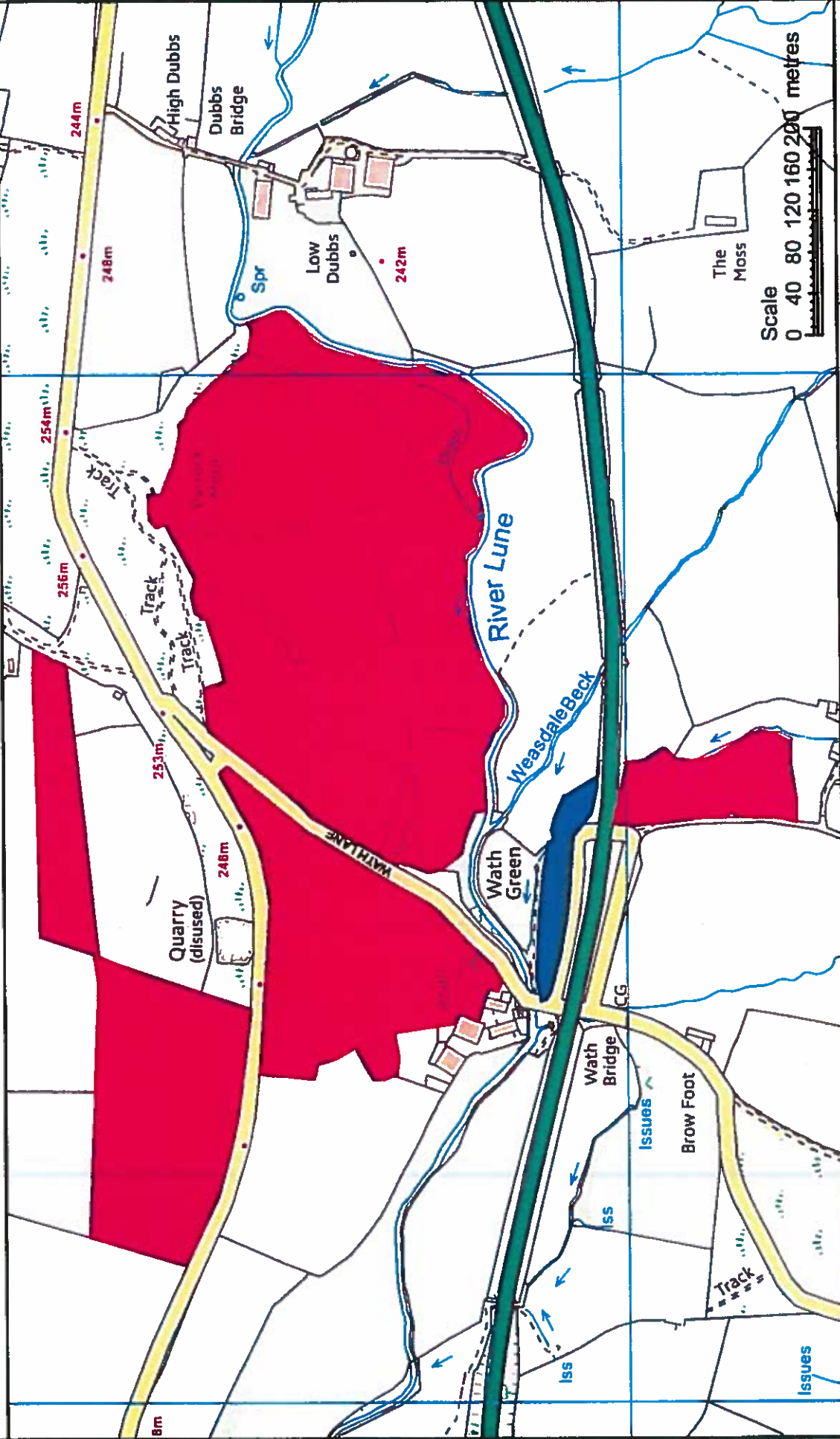
