NOTICE OF APPLICATION TO CORRECT THE REGISTER

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Mr W J Bowes** and **Mrs L A Bowes** ("the Applicants") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Section 19 (2) (a) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL20 Caldbeck Common.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The application relates to register entry number 104, which was originally created as a result of an application for amendment to register entry number 57. The Applicants claim that when making the amendment, the Commons Registration Authority failed to give, in column 5 of the register, an adequate description of the land to which the rights attach. The Applicants request that a supplemental map is added to the register to clearly define the land to which the rights attach.

If the application is granted, in whole or in part, the Commons Registration Authority will give effect to the determination by preparing a supplemental map (draft attached) to be added to the register showing the land to which the rights at register entry number 104 attach.

Any person wishing to make representations:

- must quote the Application No. **CA10/11**
- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Any representations made will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the Commons Registration Authority to disclose information received to others, which will include the Applicant and may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). Representations may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The period for making representations expires at 5pm on .
