

Commons Act 2006 - Schedule 3 para 2(b)

Application to amend the register to record an historic event

Notice is hereby given that an application has been made by **Mr Eric John Wise and Mr Robert Andrew Wise** ("The Applicants") to Cumbria County Council as Commons Registration Authority, under Schedule 3 paragraph 2(b) of the Commons Act 2006 and in accordance with the Commons Registration (England) Regulations 2014.

The application relates to common land register unit CL26 Skinburness and Calvo Marshes.

A summary of the effect of the application is as follows: The right to graze 3 stints (3 stints being equal to 3 beasts or 6 ewes and followers) on Skinburness and Calvo Marshes comprising the whole of the land in this register unit is currently registered as not attached (held in gross) at Entry 42 of register unit CL26 in the name of Eric Wise, of Low Tarns, Silloth ("the Right"). Under the terms of Mr Wise's will dated 8th May 1994 the Right passed to Judith Helen Wise. The Applicants claim to have acquired ownership of the right upon the death of Judith Helen Wise under the terms of her will dated 5th August 2009 and by way of subsequent Assent. The Assent does not operate at law to transfer the ownership of the Right until registered by the Commons Registration Authority in the register. The Applicants seek by this application to complete the transfer of ownership and register the Right in their own names.

If the application is granted, the registration authority will give effect to the determination by deleting current entries (making reference to the new corresponding entries) and making new entries in the register to show the Applicants as owners of the Right.



- must state the name and postal address of the person making them, and the nature of that person's interest (if any) in any land affected by the application and may include an e-mail address;
- must be signed by the person making them;
- must state the grounds on which they are made; and

Representations will not be treated as confidential, to determine the application it will be necessary for the authority to disclose information received from you to others, which may include other local authorities, Government Departments, public bodies, other organisations and members of the public (Data Protection Act 1998). A copy of any correspondence may be disclosed upon receipt of a request for information under the Environmental Information Regulations 2004 or the Freedom of information Act 2000.

The date on which the period for making representations expires is 5pm on 14th November 2016.
